



## **21 Days with Jesus in the Book of John**

**Daily Prayer, Fasting & Communion Guide  
January 10th-30th, 2022**

## **Day 1 (1.10.22)**

### **Read John Chapter 1**

**Focus Verse: John 1:29** “The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** *Thank Him and praise Him for what He did for you.* Praise Him for dying on the cross as your spotless, pure, righteous Lamb (Isaiah 53:7, 1 Peter 1:19, Hebrews 10:10, Hebrews 19:14-15, Revelation 5:12, Revelation 13:8). Make it personal. Let gratitude and thanksgiving overflow!

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** *Come into agreement with who He is.* “We worship You alone Jesus, the Lamb that was slain.” Even now He is still the suffering savior, the passover lamb, the only sufficient sacrifice, removing and washing away the sins of the world.

**Pray/Intercede for what only Jesus can do.** *Intercede for what only He can do.* Cry out for those in your life who need saved. Call them out by name. Pray for the salvation of Columbus, our nation and the world. Intercede for those who have yet to encounter Jesus, the Lamb that was slain for their sins! Pray that He would reveal Himself to them. That they would surrender their lives to Jesus, and experience His salvation.

## Day 2 (1.11.22)

### **Read John Chapter 2**

**Focus Verse: John 2:13-17** Now the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. 14 And He found in the temple those who sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the money changers doing business. 15 When He had made a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out the changers' money and overturned the tables. 16 And He said to those who sold doves, "Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise!" 17 Then His disciples remembered that it was written, "Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up."

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Him for cleansing the temple. Thank Him and praise Him for being the one who lived with great zeal and passion for the house of God, the one who purified His Father's House.

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Come into agreement with who He is. "Jesus You are the cleanser of the temple. You are the zealous one for the House of God!" We worship Jesus for His great passion for the glory of His Father's House.

**Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do.** Pray for increased zeal and passion for the House of God. Ask Him, "Jesus would you impart your zeal and passion for the House of God into me?" Ask Him, "Jesus, would You come and cleanse Your church? Start with me, my house, my family, our community. We ask you Jesus, the zealous one, come and purify, come and prune, come and purge anything that is not like you, for your glory!"

#### **Read John Chapter 3**

**Focus Verse: John 3:35** The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Praise Jesus for living on the earth in right relationship and alignment with His Father in heaven. Thank Jesus for living only for the glory of His Father! Thank Jesus for humbly receiving all things from His Father and showing us how to do the same.

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being the perfect Son of God. Worship Jesus as the object of His Father's love. Worship Jesus as the one the Father has entrusted all things to. All power, all authority and His Kingdom!

**Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do.** Ask Him, "Reveal yourself to me by the Holy Spirit, as the one the Father loves. I want to come into the awareness and knowledge of God's love for you Jesus. Make yourself known to the world as the object of the Father's love!"

### **Read John Chapter 4**

**Focus Verse: John 4:10** Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water (source of power, sustainability, satisfaction, unto eternal life)." (Isaiah 44:3, Jeremiah 2:13, Psalm 87:7, John 7:37-39)

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Praise Jesus for being the giver of living water. Thank Jesus for being the only one who can take away your thirst (make it personal).

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being your fountain. Worship Jesus for being your source for everlasting life!

**Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do.** "Jesus I pray for all who are thirsty, for all who are unsatisfied with the things of this world. I pray for those struggling with addiction, pornography, greed. I pray for those looking for satisfaction in other people, in things, in their social status. Would you draw them to Yourself? I pray they would find You and receive You as the giver of living water! The only one who can satisfy their thirst."

## Day 5 (1.14.22)

### Read John Chapter 5

**Focus Verse: John 5:39** You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. (Matthew 5:17, Galatians 3:21-25, 1 John 5:7)

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Praise Jesus for being the one who fulfilled the law. Thank Jesus for being the full and perfect embodiment of the Scriptures.

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being the Word Made Flesh (John 1:14). Worship Jesus for being the one the Scriptures are testifying of!

**Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do.** Pray for Jesus to reveal Himself by His Spirit to You every time you read the word. Pray for Jesus to be seen by everyone who opens up the Scriptures. Pray for the word of God to go out across Columbus, throughout this generation, around the world. Pray that Jesus would become real in the hearts and minds of all people, of every nation!

## Day 6 (1.15.22)

### Read John Chapter 6

#### Drink offering scriptures (Numbers, Leviticus etc.)

**Focus Verse: John 6:53-58** Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. 54 Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. 56 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. 57 As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. 58 This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever.”

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for giving you His body. Praise Jesus for pouring out His blood for you (make it personal). Praise Jesus for raising you up at the last day. For the hope of the resurrection!

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being the bread of life. Worship Jesus for being our sustenance, the substance of eternal life, through His body and blood.

**Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do.** If you find yourself in a place where you have stopped “feeding” on Jesus daily, even during this fast, repent and respond to His invitation. Pray for those who are following Jesus at a distance to consume Him. Pray for the grace to abide in Jesus to increase in your life, in the church overall, that we consume His body as bread and His blood as our necessary drink!

## Day 7 (1.16.22)

### **Read John Chapter 7**

**Focus Verse: John 7:37-39** On the last day, that great *day* of the feast (Feast of Tabernacles Exodus 23:16, Leviticus 23:33-44, Deuteronomy 16:13-15), Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. 38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” 39 But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for being the one who baptizes (immerses, submerges, overwhelms) us in the Holy Spirit and Fire (purifying fire) (Matthew 3:11). Praise Jesus for promising the Holy Spirit would come to us (John 14:15-17).

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus, the one anointed with the Holy Spirit and power (Acts 10:38). Worship Jesus, the one whom the Holy Spirit descended and remained upon (John 1:32). Worship Jesus, the one full of the Holy Spirit and led by the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:1).

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Ask for Jesus to baptize (immerse, submerge, overwhelm) you afresh with the Holy Spirit. Pray for rivers of living water to flow in your life daily (Ezekiel 47). Pray personally and on behalf of the church to be overcome with power to be a witness for Jesus (Acts 1:8). Pray personally and on behalf of the church of Columbus, the Bride of Christ globally to be filled with the Holy Spirit in a new and dynamic way, to declare the word of God with boldness (Acts 4:31). Pray personally and on behalf of the church for the fruit of the Spirit to manifest (Galatians 5:22), and to daily be led by the Spirit of God (Romans 8:14), who affirms that we are adopted sons and daughters of God (Romans 8:15).

## Day 8 (1.17.22)

### **Read John Chapter 8**

**Focus Verse: John 8:12** Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for coming as the light of the world. Praise Jesus for affirming us as sons and daughters of the light (1 Thes 5:5). Praise Jesus for shielding us from darkness as we commit to following Him.

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being the true light of the world (John 1:9). Worship Him for being the one in whom no darkness dwells.

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Pray that you would personally grow in your desire to love light and hate darkness. Ask for Jesus to open up the eyes of this generation to see that He is the light of life! Pray for the Lord to expose darkness in the world and in hearts. Pray that Jesus would cause the body of Christ in Columbus and globally, to continue to walk in the light of Christ so that they will not walk in darkness.

## Day 9 (1.18.22)

### **Read John Chapter 9**

**Focus Verse: John 9:30-33** The man answered and said to them, "Why, this is a marvelous thing, that you do not know where He is from; yet He has opened my eyes! 31 Now we know that God does not hear sinners; but if anyone is a worshiper of God and does His will, He hears him. 32 Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind. 33 If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing."

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for being sent from the Father. Praise Him for opening the eyes of the blind (both spiritually and physically). Praise Him for living to do the will of His father at all times (John 6:38)! Praise Him for continuing to confirm the message of salvation through miracles, signs, and wonders (Hebrews 2:4)! He still does miracles!

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being our source! Worship Him for being the one in whom we find healing and restoration.

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Pray that Jesus would enlighten the eyes of your understanding (Eph 1:18) and reveal the hope of His calling to your heart. Ask Him to open up the eyes of the blind and reveal Himself as healer to this generation (Matt 9:35). Pray that He would release miracles, signs, and wonders through (and within) our community as we contend for the salvation of Columbus!

**Focus Verse: John 10:9-11** I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. 10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly. 11 “I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for inviting us into the abundant life. Thank Him for the gift of salvation. Praise Jesus for giving His life for the sheep (us). Praise Him for making a way for us to enter into rightful fellowship with the Father.

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus for being the only way to salvation (Acts 4:12). Worship Him for being the Good Shepherd. Worship Him for being the one who willingly lays His life down! (John 10:18)

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Pray that Jesus would continue to reveal Himself as The Good Shepherd to your heart (Psalm 23). Pray for grace to consistently trust in His leadership for your life. Ask Him to expose every other god as an idol in our city and nation (Psalm 96:5). Ask Him to reveal Himself as the door to those who are lost and bound by deception. Declare in prayer that salvation comes through Jesus!

**Focus Verse: John 11:25** Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for resurrecting! Thank Him for granting eternal life to those who believe (1 John 5:11). Praise Jesus for inviting us into resurrection power that is found through fellowship with Him! (Phil. 3:10-11)

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus as the one who lives because He has been given the keys of death (Rev.1:17-18)! Worship Him as the ascended Christ! The One who is now and forever seated at the right hand of the Father (Eph. 1:20-23).

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Pray that Jesus would stamp eternity on your heart. Pray that He would cause your heart to hasten His return. Ask Him to baptize the Body of Christ with resurrection power. Pray for grace to know Him in the power of His resurrection AND the fellowship of His suffering (Phil 3:10).

### **Read John Chapter 12**

**Focus Verse: John 12:12-13** The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, 13 took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! The King of Israel!"

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Him for being Israel's savior. Thank Him for bringing salvation to the Gentiles (us) and provoking the apple of His eye to jealousy (Romans 11:11). Praise Him for His commitment to bringing us all into the family of God!

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus, the King of Israel! Worship Him as King of all nations and Kings (Isaiah 9:6-7).

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Pray that Jesus would give you a heart for the nation of Israel. Ask Him to increase your understanding and bring you into alignment with His desire for Israel's salvation (Romans 10). Ask Him to stir your heart and renew your devotion in the place of worship. Pray that all the nations of the earth would receive Jesus as King (Psalm 2:8), for He desires the nations!

### Read John Chapter 13

**Focus Verse: John 13:3-5** Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, 4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. 5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel with which He was girded.

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for His excellent leadership. Thank Him for teaching us the wisdom of the Kingdom. Thank Him for revealing that the greatest of all is a servant of all (Mark 9:35). Praise Him for the gift of intimacy. Praise Him for drawing near to us.

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus as our perfect teacher (verse 13)!. Worship Him as the word made flesh (John 1:14).

**Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone.** Pray that Jesus would awaken intimacy as you commit to seeking His heart. Ask Him to reveal Himself as teacher while meditating on the scriptures. Pray that the Body of Christ would walk in humility like never before (James 4:10). Ask Him to continue revealing the wisdom of the Kingdom to believers all across the earth.

**Thanksgiving/Praise for what Jesus has done.** Thank Jesus for preparing a place for us with the Father (John 14:2). Thank Him for revealing the Father through himself! Praise Him for living to intercede on our behalf before God (Hebrews 7:25)!

**Worship Jesus for who He is.** Worship Jesus as the way, the truth, and the life. Worship Jesus as the door through which we have gained access to the Father! Worship Him as the mediator between God and men (1 Tim 2:5).
