



24 Days With Jesus In The Book of Luke (Days 1-7)

Day 1 (1.8.25)

Read Luke Chapter 1

Focus Verses: Luke 1:30-33 (NIV) But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. **31** You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. **32** He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, **33** and he will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; his kingdom will never end."

Give Thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Thank Jesus for coming into the world. Give praise to Jesus for being the evidence of God's faithfulness. Praise Jesus for his humility, entering into the world as a baby through His mother Mary.

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus for being the Son of the Most High. Worship Jesus for being the ruler of the everlasting kingdom, the one who will sit on David's throne!

Pray/Intercede for what only Jesus can do. Ask Jesus to reveal Himself through the gospel. Ask Jesus to increase your awareness of His leadership and kingdom.

Response Verses: Luke 1:76-79 (NIV) And you, my child (John the Baptist), will be called a prophet of the Most High; for you will go on before the Lord to prepare the way for him, **77** to give his people the knowledge of salvation through the forgiveness of their sins, **78** because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven **79** to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace."

Teach us to prepare the way for You Jesus. Use us to prepare a way for Your light, salvation, mercy, and peace everywhere we go!

Day 2 (1.9.25)
Read Luke Chapter 2

Focus Verses: Luke 2:27-32 (NIV) Moved by the Spirit, he went into the temple courts. When the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the custom of the Law required, **28** Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying: **29** "Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace. **30** For my eyes have seen your salvation, **31** which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: **32** a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel."

Give Thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Praise Jesus for being the evidence of God's sovereignty, faithfulness and promises to Israel and the nations!

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus for being the light to the nations and the glory of Israel.

Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do. Ask Jesus to draw all nations to Himself (John 12:32). Ask Jesus to give you a burden for the salvation of Israel (Romans 9:1-5).

Response Verses: Luke 2:46-49 (NIV) After three days they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. **47** Everyone who heard him was amazed at his understanding and his answers. **48** When his parents saw him, they were astonished. His mother said to him, "Son, why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for you." **49** "Why were you searching for me?" he asked. "Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?"

Jesus, make us like You. We want to be about the Father's business!

Day 3 (1.10.25)
Read Luke Chapter 3

Focus Verses: Luke 3:21-22 (NIV) When all the people were being baptized, Jesus was baptized too. And as he was praying, heaven was opened **22** and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

Give Thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Thank Jesus for being our example and model by being baptized in water.

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus, the one who the Holy Spirit rested and remained upon. Worship Jesus, the one the Father's pleasure rests upon.

Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do. Ask Jesus to teach you to carry the presence of the Holy Spirit like He did. Ask Jesus to show you how to find your identity in the pleasure of the Father.

Response Verses: Luke 3:3-4 (NIV) He went into all the country around the Jordan, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. **4** As it is written in the book of the words of Isaiah the prophet: "A voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him."

*Make us voices of truth in our generation. Make us voices that point all people to You
Jesus!*

Day 4 (1.11.25)
Read Luke Chapter 4

Focus Verses: Luke 4:16-19 (NIV) He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, **17** and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written: **18** "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, **19** to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Give Thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Give thanks to Jesus today for His obedience to His calling. Praise Jesus for preaching good news to the poor and for liberating the oppressed!

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus for being the anointed One. Worship Jesus for being the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies. Worship Jesus for being the healer of blind of eyes, and the proclaimer of the Lord's favor!

Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do. Ask Jesus to give grace to the lost to respond to the good news of salvation. Ask Jesus to give strength to the oppressed and for His justice to prevail.

Response Verses: Luke 4:42-44 (NIV) At daybreak, Jesus went out to a solitary place. The people were looking for him and when they came to where he was, they tried to keep him from leaving them. **43** But he said, "I must proclaim the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns also, because that is why I was sent." **44** And he kept on preaching in the synagogues of Judea.

Thank you Jesus for your example. Give us your passion to share the good news of the Kingdom of God from city to city, for your glory!

Day 5 (1.12.25)
Read Luke Chapter 5

Focus Verses: Luke 5:22-26 (NIV) But Jesus knew what they were thinking and asked, "Why are you thinking these things in your hearts? **23** Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'? **24** But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." So he said to the paralyzed man, "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home." **25** Immediately he stood up in front of them, took what he had been lying on and went home praising God. **26** Everyone was amazed and gave praise to God. They were filled with awe and said, "We have seen remarkable things today."

Give Thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Praise Jesus for forgiving our sins, your sins. Give praise to Jesus for His authority over sin and sickness!

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus, the Son of Man! Worship Jesus, our healer and deliverer.

Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do. Ask Jesus to increase the awareness of the need for forgiveness of sins in the lives of those you know who are not saved. Ask Jesus to increase desperation and desire for encounters with Him in the hearts of those you know who are lost.

Response Verses: Luke 5:33-35 (NIV) They said to him, "John's disciples often fast and pray, and so do the disciples of the Pharisees, but yours go on eating and drinking." **34** Jesus answered, "Can you make the friends of the bridegroom fast while he is with them? **35** But the time will come when the bridegroom will be taken from them; in those days they will fast."

Thank you Jesus for increasing our desire for You. May this fast bring us closer to You, as your Bride. Intensify our longing for You throughout this year!

Day 6 (1.13.25)
Read Luke Chapter 6

Focus Verses: Luke 6:27-31 (NIV) “But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, **28** bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. **29** If someone slaps you on one cheek, turn to them the other also. If someone takes your coat, do not withhold your shirt from them. **30** Give to everyone who asks you, and if anyone takes what belongs to you, do not demand it back. **31** Do to others as you would have them do to you.

Give Thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Praise Jesus for teaching us the values of the kingdom of God. Praise Jesus for calling us into a higher standard of living!

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus, our perfect example of what living out the characteristics of God’s kingdom looks like. Worship Jesus, the most integral, caring, loving man to ever live.

Pray/Intercede for what He alone can do. Intercede and ask Jesus to help the Church to walk out the Sermon on the Mount. Ask Jesus to help you live up to the values of His kingdom each and everyday, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Response Verses: Luke 6:46-49 (NIV) “Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say? **47** As for everyone who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice, I will show you what they are like. **48** They are like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built. **49** But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete.”

Jesus, help us to not just say that you are the Lord of our lives. Help us to obey you and by doing so prove that you are the Lord of our lives. Make us like the man who built his house on a strong foundation.

Day 7 (1.14.25)
Read Luke Chapter 7

Focus Verses: Luke 7:44-48 (NIV) Then he turned toward the woman and said to Simon, “Do you see this woman? I came into your house. You did not give me any water for my feet, but she wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. **45** You did not give me a kiss, but this woman, from the time I entered, has not stopped kissing my feet. **46** You did not put oil on my head, but she has poured perfume on my feet. **47** Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—as her great love has shown. But whoever has been forgiven little loves little.” **48** Then Jesus said to her, “Your sins are forgiven.”

Give thanks/Praise for what Jesus has done. Praise Jesus for being the one who always sees us. Praise Jesus for always showing the mercy of the Father!

Worship Jesus for who He is. Worship Jesus, the only one who deserves our costly and sacrificial devotion. Worship Jesus, the one who sees how much we love Him!

Pray/Intercede for what He can do alone. Intercede for those who feel like they are too far from God. Ask Jesus to show them that His arm is not too short to rescue them. Ask Jesus to reveal to them that He is still pursuing them and desires to rescue them!

Response Verses: Luke 7:40-43 (NIV) Jesus answered him, “Simon, I have something to tell you.” “Tell me, teacher,” he said. **41** “Two people owed money to a certain moneylender. One owed him five hundred denarii,^[c] and the other fifty. **42** Neither of them had the money to pay him back, so he forgave the debts of both. Now which of them will love him more?” **43** Simon replied, “I suppose the one who had the bigger debt forgiven.” “You have judged correctly,” Jesus said.

Jesus, help us to never take for granted how much You have forgiven us. Help us to show our gratitude for Your mercy everyday.
